

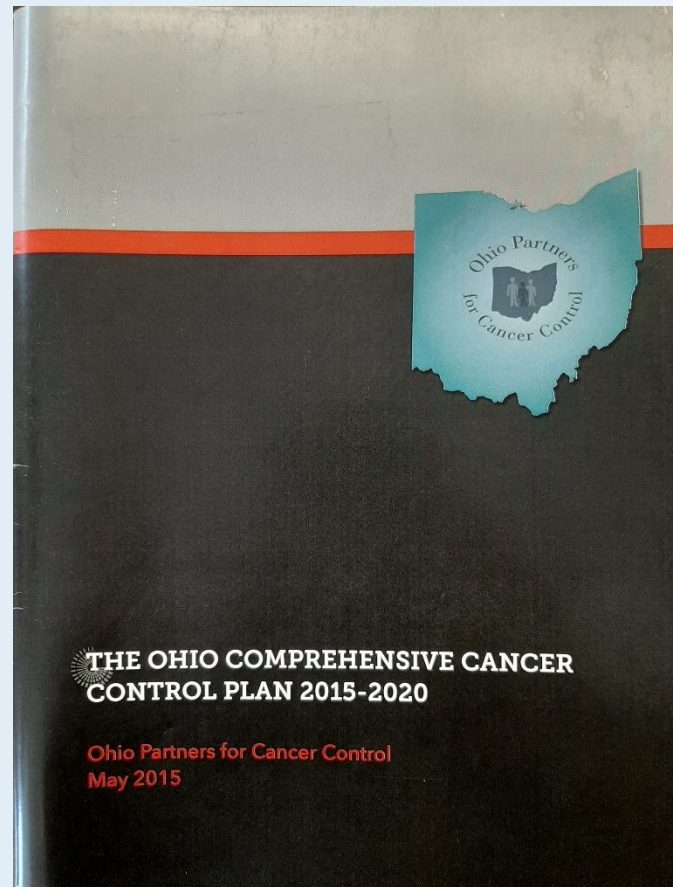

The OPCC Executive Committee began planning in December for the kick-off of the revised Cancer Plan.

- Ohio Department of Health with PDA as facilitator.

What is the Cancer Plan?

- Strategic plan to reduce the cancer burden in Ohio.
- Provide guidance to individuals and organizations that can play a role in controlling cancer.
- Several aspects of the cancer continuum are addressed (e.g., primary prevention, early detection, patient-centered services).
- Intended to direct collective efforts toward specific and measurable objectives.

When will we revise the plan?

2020 OPCC meetings

- March 12, 2020
- July 9, 2020
- November 12, 2020

Why a 10 year plan?

- Big undertaking - OPCC and ODH will spend a year revising the plan.
- Not likely to see significant progress towards achieving some objectives in a 5-year plan.
- Opportunity to evaluate incrementally and adjust course.

How will we revise the plan?

Several milestones are established to keep the plan on track to be in place by January 1, 2021.

What is the first step?

The first step is developing plan objectives.

- 2015-2020 plan = 28 objectives
- 2021 – 2030 = ? objectives
- Stakeholder survey
- Topic workgroups (e.g., vaccines, genetics, lung cancer detection)
- Workgroups draft 1-3 objectives by June 5

What is the next step?

The next step will be to draft strategies.

- OPCC members will draft a strategy/strategies for each objective.
- Evidence-based strategies.

July  August

When will OPCC see the final plan?

- Throughout the process, the OPCC Executive Committee/Revision Team and ODH will be writing (e.g., executive summary, introduction) and working on layout.
- Final plan will be presented to OPCC membership at November meeting.
- OPCC will then select priority objectives.
